[Supporting the California Faculty Association]

Resolution supporting the California Faculty Association and urging the California State University (CSU) administration give the CSU faculty the respect they deserve and agree to the reasonable salary increases they demand.

WHEREAS, The 23-campus California State University (CSU) system is a vital part of the California Master Plan for Higher Education; and

WHEREAS, The average faculty pay is \$46,016, average lecturer pay is \$27,567, while the average managers pay is \$110,713, average CSU President's pay is \$320,644, and CSU Chancellor White's pay is \$430,746; and

WHEREAS, A CSU 2015 faculty survey found that 34% have student debt, 60% cannot afford housing in their campus community, 72% take on additional work and 79% would not recommend their jobs to students or colleagues; and

WHEREAS, Between 2005 and 2015 the number of students has increased by 24%, the number of managers went up 22%, the number of tenure track faculty fell 2% and the number of lecturers increased 24%; and

WHEREAS, Faculty have not received a service salary increase since 2007/2008 and out of the last seven years received 0% general salary increase three of those years, a 10% cut in 2009, and 1.6% or less since 2012/2013; and

WHEREAS, The poor compensation, increase in work load and resulting decrease in morale amongst the faculty make it difficult to recruit and retain quality educators; and

WHEREAS, The union is demanding a 5% general salary increase and a 2.65% service salary increase (equivalent to a step increase) for eligible faculty in year 2 of the contract; and

WHEREAS, The CSU faculty has voted by 94.4% to authorize a strike in the event that the administration does not meet their demands; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors support the educators of the CSU system and support them in their efforts to achieve a satisfactory contract agreement; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors recommends the CSU administration give the CSU faculty the respect they deserve and agree to the reasonable salary increases they demand.
