15 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

16 Section 1. General Background and Findings.

17 (a) The Humidor was founded in Santa Rosa in the mid-1980s as a family business
18 by Baram Bakhshi, Javid Bakhshi, Jamshid Bakhshi, and Habid Bakhshi. The Humidor moved
19 to San Francisco in 1990 and has occupied several different locations in San Francisco. It
20 has been in operation in San Francisco (with no breaks in operation of more than two years)
21 for a 26 years. In 2003, The Humidor moved to One Embarcadero Center, into a space that
22 had previously been operated as a Tobacco Shop. In 2006, The Humidor moved into a new
23 location at 275 Battery Street. It has been at that location from 2006 to 2016. During the
24 entirety of its operations in San Francisco, The Humidor has been a Tobacco Shop operating
25 with a tobacco sales permit.

1 (b) The Humidor has been nominated for inclusion on the Legacy Business Registry
2 as a longstanding, community serving business and a valuable cultural asset of the City.

3 (c) In late 2015, the building at 275 Battery Street was sold to new owners who
4 have refused to renew The Humidor's lease. The Humidor, after negotiations with a new
5 landlord, is entering into a lease for a space at One Embarcadero Center, which is not the
6 space it occupied there from 2003 to 2006.

7 (d) Section 19H.5 of the Health Code caps the number of establishments with
8 tobacco sales permits in every supervisorial district at 45. Further, Section 19H.4(f)(5) of the
9 Health Code states that no new tobacco sales permit shall be issued in any supervisorial
10 district that has 45 or more establishments with tobacco sales permits. The supervisorial
11 district in which The Humidor intends to be located, at One Embarcadero Center, is the same
12 supervisorial district where The Humidor has been located, at 275 Battery Street, and the
13 district has 45 or more establishments with tobacco sales permits.

14 (e) Section 19H.4(f)(7) of the Health Code states that no new permits shall be
15 issued for the operation of a Tobacco Shop. The Humidor is a Tobacco Shop.

16 (f) Based on the facts as stated in this Section 1, reasonable grounds support
17 granting The Humidor an exception to Sections 19H.4(f)(5) and 19H.4(f)(7) of the Health
18 Code, and Section 19H.5 to the extent that that section reiterates the ban on issuance of more
19 than 45 tobacco sales permits in a supervisorial district. The Humidor is a longstanding
20 holder of a tobacco sales permit. Its new location, at One Embarcadero Street, is less than
21 300 feet away from its previous location at 275 Battery Street, and is in the same supervisorial
22 district. Issuing a tobacco sales permit to The Humidor at its new location will not change the
23 number of such permits in that supervisorial district that existed when The Humidor had its
24 tobacco sales permit at its previous location on Battery Street. Further, the space occupied
25 by The Humidor at 275 Battery Street is approximately 970 square feet, while the space that

1 Humidor plans to occupy at One Embarcadero Center is approximately 730 square feet.
2 Accordingly, The Humidor will be devoting fewer square feet to tobacco product sales at One
3 Embarcadero Center than at its previous location at 275 Battery Street.


4 Section 2. Exemption of The Humidor From Certain Requirements of Health Code
5 Sections 19H.4 and 19H.5.

6 For the reasons stated in Section 1 of this ordinance, The Humidor, under its current
7 ownership, is hereby exempted from the requirements of Sections 19H.4(f)(5) and 19H.4(f)(7)
8 of the Health Code, and Section 19H.5 to the extent that that section reiterates the ban on
9 issuance of more than 45 tobacco sales permits in a supervisorial district. In providing for this
10 exemption, it is intended that the aforementioned provisions not serve as a barrier to The
11 Humidor's obtaining a tobacco sales permit at its new location at One Embarcadero Center.
12 This ordinance is intended to apply solely to that location.

13 Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
14 enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
15 ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
16 of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Health Code - Exempting The Humidor from Certain Provisions of the Tobacco Sales Permit Ordinance]

Ordinance exempting The Humidor, formerly located at 275 Battery Street, from two prohibitions in the Tobacco Sales Permit Ordinance on the issuance of such a permit for The Humidor's new location at One Embarcadero Center: the prohibitions on issuing the permit in a Supervisorial District with 45 or more such permits, and on issuing the permit to a tobacco shop.

Existing Law

Section 19H.5 of the Health Code caps the number of establishments with tobacco sales permits in every supervisorial district at 45. Further, Section 19H.4(f)(5) of the Health Code states that no new tobacco sales permit shall be issued in any supervisorial district that has 45 or more establishments with tobacco sales permits.

Section 19H.4(f)(7) of the Health Code states that no new permits shall be issued for the operation of a Tobacco Shop.

Amendments to Current Law

This proposed ordinance will allow an exception to the requirements in Sections 19H.4 and 19H.5 for The Humidor. The Humidor is a longstanding holder of a tobacco sales permit. Its new location, at One Embarcadero Street, is less than 300 feet away from its previous location at 275 Battery Street, and is in the same supervisorial district. Issuing a tobacco sales permit to The Humidor at its new location will not change the number of such permits in that supervisorial district that existed when The Humidor held a tobacco sales permit at its previous location on Battery Street. Further, the space occupied by The Humidor at 275 Battery St. is approximately 970 square feet, while the space that The Humidor plans to occupy at One Embarcadero Center is approximately 730 square feet. Accordingly, The Humidor will be devoting fewer square feet to tobacco product sales at One Embarcadero Center than at its previous location at 275 Battery Street.

SUBJECT: Health Code - Exempting The Humidor from Certain Provisions of the Tobacco Sales Permit Ordinance

Dear Supervisor Peskin:

The San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFPDH) is writing in regard to File No. 160253 which would exempt the Humidor from provisions in the Tobacco Sales Permit Ordinance. SFPDH is aware that the Humidor Tobacco Shop was unable to renew its lease after 10 years of business at 275 Battery Street in Supervisorial District 3 and is seeking a new tobacco sales permit at One Embarcadero Center. We understand the predicament that this creates for the owners of this family business. However, the Tobacco Sales Permit Ordinance (File No. 141098) which was passed by the Board of Supervisors in December of 2014, aims to reduce the density of tobacco providers through attrition in order to counteract the disproportionate distribution of tobacco permits among supervisorial districts.

Though the Humidor was a longstanding holder of a tobacco sales permit, the intent of the Tobacco Sales Permit Ordinance is to decrease opportunities for tobacco sales in San Francisco, and reduce disproportionate exposure to tobacco outlets that exist among supervisorial districts. Supervisorial District 3 contains the greatest number of stores selling tobacco compared to other districts (167 stores), contains 18% of all tobacco retailers in San Francisco, and has one of the lowest median household incomes. Research shows that communities in lower socio-economic areas with a higher concentration of stores have significantly higher rates of smoking. Similarly, communities with a higher concentration of stores that sell tobacco also have a higher youth smoking rate.

Tobacco is the leading cause of preventable death in the United States. Areas with high smoking prevalence also have greater exposure to secondhand smoke for non-smokers which can exacerbate a wide range of health effects. For these reasons, the Department of Public Health opposes an exception to the law that was intended to support the health of San Francisco's youth and residents.

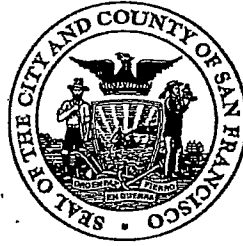
