8 hereby appoint the following designated persons to serve as members of the In-Home
9 Supportive Services Public Authority, pursuant to the provisions of California Welfare and
10 Institutions Code, Section 12301.6, and San Francisco Administrative Code, Chapter 70, for
11 the terms specified:

12 Patricia Webb, seat 2, succeeding herself, term expired, must be a consumer
13 between the ages of 18 and 60, authorized to represent organizations that advocate for
14 younger people with disabilities, for a three-year term ending March 1, 2019.

15 Patricia Wooley, seat 4, succeeding herself, term expired, must be a worker who
16 provides personal assistance services to a consumer, for a three-year term ending March 1,
17 2019.

18 Rita Semel, seat 6, succeeding herself, term expired, must be a member of the
19 Human Services Commission, recommended to the Board by the Commission, for a three-
20 year term ending March 1, 2019.

21 Judith Karshmer, seat 8, succeeding herself, term expired, must be a member of the
22 Health Commission, recommended to the Board by the Commission, for a three-year term
23 ending March 1, 2019.

1 Tatiana Kostanian, seat 8, succeeding herself, term expired, must be a member of
2 the Mayor's Disability Council, recommended to the Board by the Council, for a three-year
3 term ending March 1, 2019.

4 Melvin Beetle, seat 10, succeeding himself, term expired, must be a consumer over
5 the age of 55, authorized to represent organizations that advocate for aging people with
6 disabilities, for a three-year term ending March 1, 2019.
