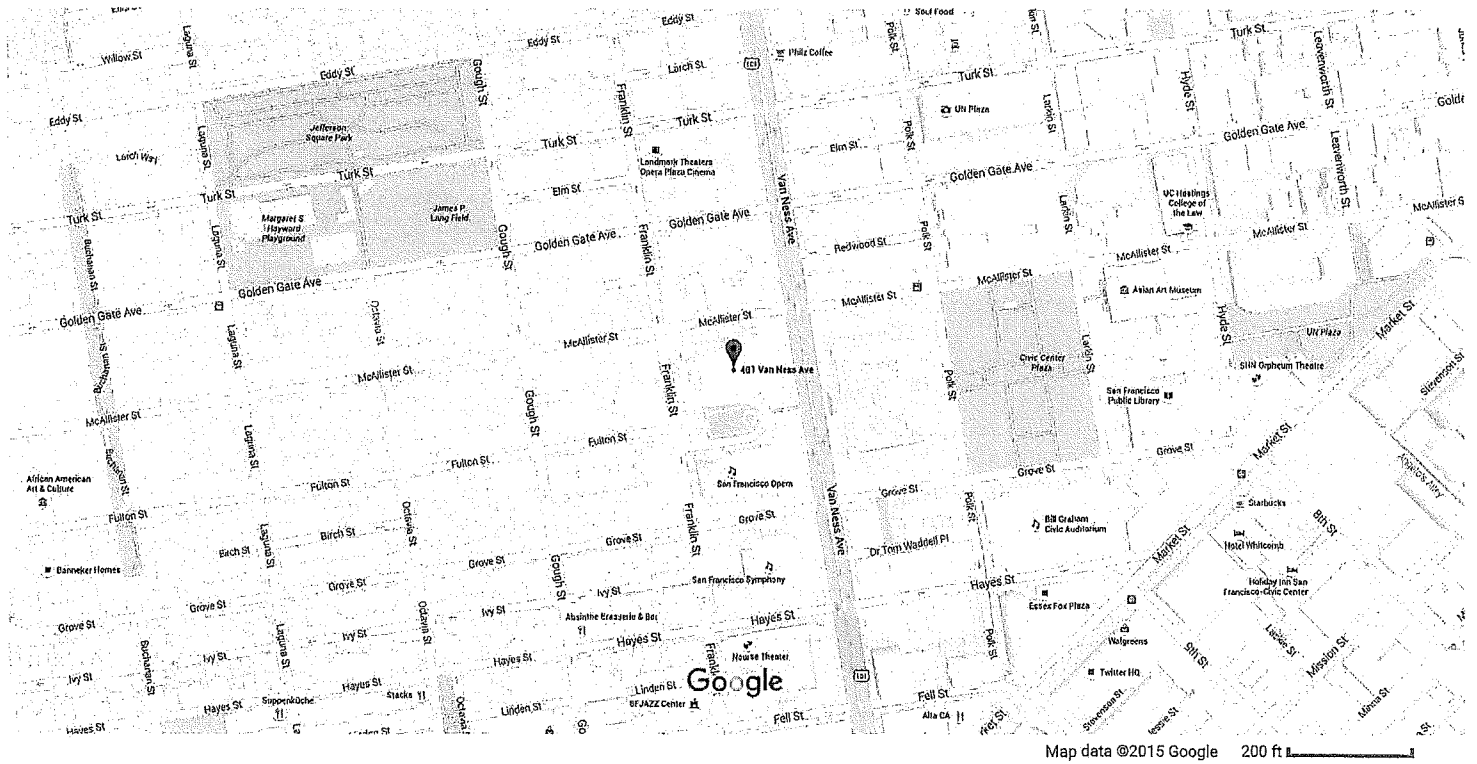
- 1 Sales, service, and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only between the hours of 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m.
- 2 The sale and serving of alcoholic beverages shall be limited to ticketholders only during, and two hours prior to and one hour after, a bona fide theater performance of the theater company. A bona fide theater performance is defined as the "licensee must actually operate a troupe of actors or other performers for the purpose of putting on a performance".
- 3 Sales, service, and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be made only from stationary bars or portable bars and waiter/waitress service; and shall not be sold, served, or delivered to customers by individual ambulatory vendors.
- 4 The sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption off the premises is strictly prohibited.
- 5 Alcoholic beverages shall be limited to no more than 2 beverages per person per sale.
- 6 Alcoholic beverages shall be served in containers clearly distinguishable from non-alcoholic beverage containers.
- 7 An employee or security guard shall be assigned the responsibility of ensuring all alcoholic beverages remain inside the permitted area whenever the privileges of the ABC license are being exercised.

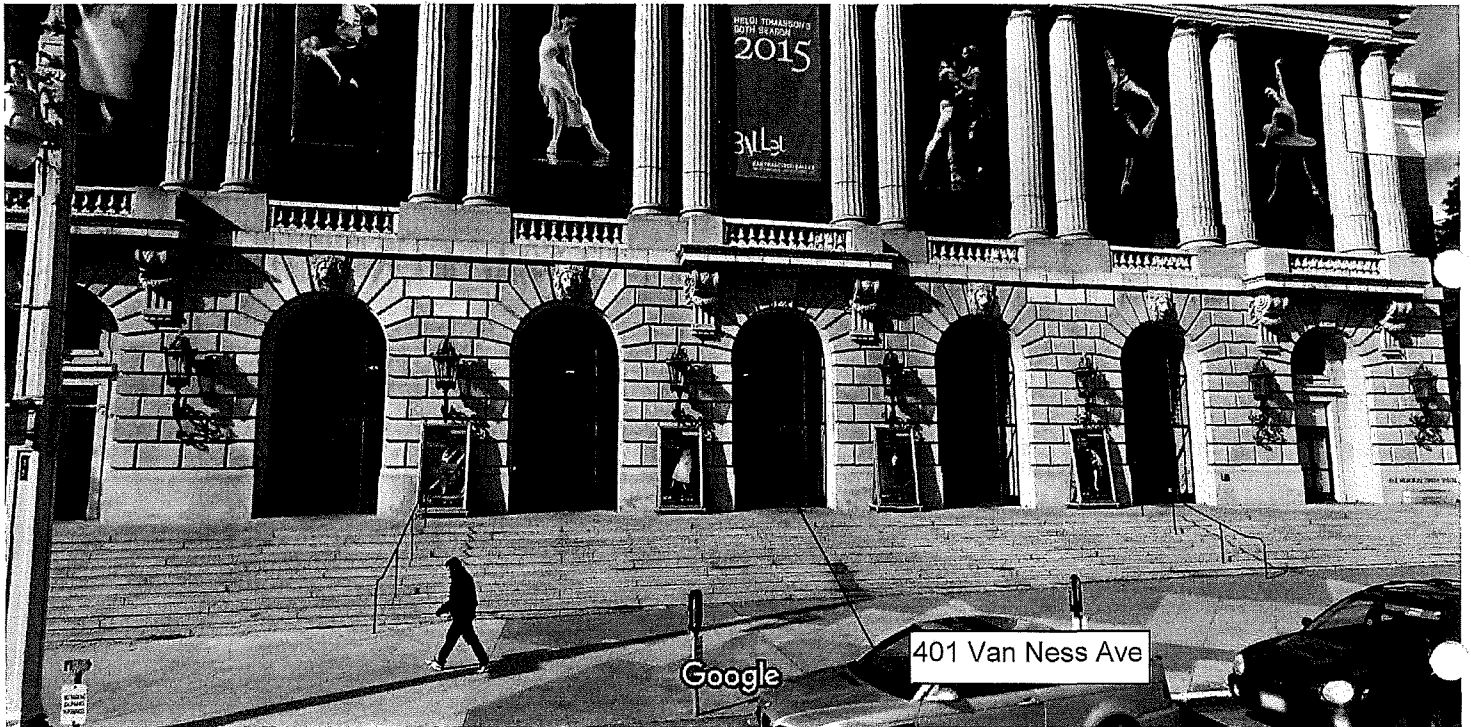

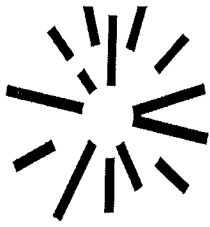

The purpose of this letter is to request to be placed on the Board's Calendar for Public Convenience and Necessity with regard to the San Francisco Opera Association's application for a Type 64 Theater License for the new Wilsey Center for Opera and our new 299- seat flexible theater space the Dianne and Tad Taube Atrium Theater on the 4th Floor of 401 Van Ness Avenue.


The Veterans Building recently re-opened in September following a 26-month, \$156 million City sponsored seismic retrofit, as well as a \$21 million Opera sponsored theatrical space and tenant improvement project. The centerpiece of the Opera's project is a unique venue, the Diane B. Wilsey Center for Opera, where the 4th floor of the Veterans Building will come alive once again with public performances in the newly established Taube Atrium Theater, a state-of-the-art performance venue designed to be configured in multiple ways, providing both performer and audience members with a very personal approach to the concert experience. From traditional theater-style performances and seating, to cabaret settings with café tables and performances in the round, to more experimental configurations, the Taube Atrium Theater will offer intimate and adventurous experiences.

In order to best accommodate our patrons we would like to provide beverage service and light concessions for each of our performances. Hours of operation will begin 90 minutes prior to each performance and one hour post performance, depending on the program. By operating our own services at this relatively small performance space we will save on the wear and tear of the venue, and provide convenience to our patrons and the public considering the theater is on the fourth floor of the War Memorial Veteran's Building. Since SFMOMA last occupied this space in 1994 there has been no concessionaire, so this is a new license.

San Francisco Opera is committed to consolidating our facilities at Civic Center and expanding the increasingly vibrant performing arts offerings in the district.

We seek the San Francisco Board of Supervisors affirmative ruling that our application serves the public convenience and necessity of our City.

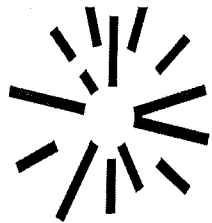
