1 [Liquor License - 36 West Portal] 2 3 Resolution determining that the issuance of a Type 21 off-sale general license to Issa Haddad for West Portal Daily Xpress located at 36 West Portal Street (District 4 5 7), will serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and County of San 6 Francisco, in accordance with California Business and Professions Code, Section 7 23958.4, and recommending that the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage 8 Control impose conditions on the issuance of the license. 9 10 WHEREAS, Issa Haddad is seeking the issuance of a Type 21 off-sale general 11 license for West Portal Daily Xpress located at 36 West Portal Street (District 7); and 12 WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly 13 zoned and recommends approval; and 14 WHEREAS, The Police Department has filed zero (0) protests with the 15 Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control under California Business and Professions 16 Code, Section 24013, and recommends that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage 17 Control issue the liquor license with conditions; and 18 WHEREAS. The conditions recommended by the Police Department are the following: 1) sales of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted between the hours of 8:00 19 20 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. each day of the week; 2) no pre-package beer or malt beverages 21 shall not be sold as a single unit; 3) no wine shall be sold with an alcoholic content of 22 greater than 15% by volume except for "dinner wines" which have been aged two years 23 or more maintained in corded bottles; 4) no distilled spirits shall be sold in bottles or 24 containers smaller than 600 ml; 5) beer, malt beverages, and wine coolers in containers

of 16 oz. or less cannot be sold by single containers, but must be sold in manufacturer

1	pre-packaged multi-unit quantities; and 6) the sale, service, and consumption of
2	powdered alcohol or like non-liquid alcoholic beverage based product is prohibited; now
3	therefore, be it
4	RESOLVED, That in accordance with California Business and Professions Code,
5	Section 23958.4, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
6	hereby determines for the foregoing reasons that the issuance of a Type 21 off-sale
7	general license to Issa Haddad for West Portal Daily Xpress located at 36 West Portal
8	Street (District 7), will serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and County
9	of San Francisco; and, be it
10	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of
11	San Francisco hereby endorses and adopts the recommendations of the Police
12	Department listed above and recommends that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage
13	Control issue the license with those conditions.
