Resolution declaring October 1, 2016, to be Bay Day in the City and County of San Francisco.

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Bay is central to the quality of life of all residents of the City and County of San Francisco and the Bay Area; and

WHEREAS, Bay Day will highlight the work of Save The Bay and other environmental organizations and individuals to improve the health of San Francisco Bay over the past fifty years; now, therefore, be it
