3 **Resolution approving settlement of an administrative civil liability complaint proposed**
4 **by California Regional Water Quality Control Board against the City and County of San**
5 **Francisco for \$611,100; the complaint is entitled In the matter of SAN FRANCISCO**
6 **PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION; February 8, 2014, Discharge of Chlorinated Treated**
7 **Wastewater; February 8, 2014, Discharge of Undisinfected Partially Treated**
8 **Wastewater; July 19, 2014, Discharge of Chlorinated Treated Wastewater; July 21, 2014,**
9 **Discharge of Partially Treated Wastewater; the matter involves alleged violations of**
10 **combined sewage discharge permit limitations; the settlement also provides for**
11 **penalty suspension pending completion of a supplemental environmental project.**

12 WHEREAS, California Regional Water Quality Control Board proposes to issue an
13 administrative civil liability complaint to the City and County of San Francisco; and

14 WHEREAS, The claim involves alleged violations of combined sewage discharge
15 permit limitations; and

16 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Public Utilities Commission has recommended
17 settlement of the claim by payment of \$611,100; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That pursuant to Administrative Code, Section 10.22, the Board of
19 Supervisors authorizes the City Attorney to settle the action entitled In the matter of SAN
20 FRANCISCO PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION; February 8, 2014, Discharge of Chlorinated
21 Treated Wastewater; February 8, 2014, Discharge of Undisinfected Partially Treated
22 Wastewater; July 19, 2014, Discharge of Chlorinated Treated Wastewater; July 21, 2014,
23 Discharge of Partially Treated Wastewater by the payment of \$611,100, which will be
24 suspended pending completion of a supplemental environmental project, for alleged violations
25 of combined sewage discharge permits.
