WHEREAS, Surinder Singh is seeking the transfer of a Type 20 off-sale beer and wine license from 5900 3rd Street to 644 Mission Street (District 6) dba 7-Eleven Store #2366-36039A; and

WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly zoned and recommends approval; and

WHEREAS, The Police Department has filed zero (0) protests with the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control under California Business and Professions Code, Section 24013, and recommends that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control issue the liquor license with conditions; and

WHEREAS, The conditions recommended by the Police Department are the following: 1) sales of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 midnight daily; 2) no more than 5% of the square footage of the premises will be used for the display of alcoholic beverages; 3) no noise shall be audible beyond the area under control of the licensee as defined of the ABC-257; 4) loitering (is defined as "to stand idly about; linger aimlessly without lawful business") is

prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent o the licensed premises under the control of the licensee as depicted on the ABC-257; 5) no person under the age of 21 shall sell or deliver alcoholic beverages; 6) no malt beverage shall be sold with an alcoholic content greater than 5.7% by volume; 7) the sales of beer or malted beverage in quantities of 16 oz., 20 oz., 32 oz., 40 oz., or similar size containers is prohibited; 8) no beer or malt beverages shall be sold in quantities of less than manufacturer prepacked six packs per sale with the exception of wine-coolers, beer coolers which must be sold in manufacturer pre-packed multi-unit quantities of four (4) or more; 9) no wine shall be sold with an alcoholic content of greater than 15% by volume except for "Dinner Wines" which have been aged two years or more and maintained in corked bottles; 10) wine shall not be sold in bottles or containers smaller than 750 ml; and 11) the sale, service and consumption of powdered alcohol or like non-liquid alcoholic beverage based product is prohibited; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That in accordance with California Business and Professions Code, Section 23958.4, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby determines that the transfer of a Type 20 off-sale beer and wine license from 5900 3rd Street to 644 Mission Street (District 6) to Surinder Singh dba 7-Eleven Store #2366-36039A, will serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and County of San Francisco; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby endorses and adopts the recommendations of the Police Department listed above and recommends that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control issue the license with those conditions.
