





Improvements Underway

- Expansion of Access to Housing Program
 - Increased rental readiness workshops (3766 people assisted)
- DAHLIA: Database of Affordable Housing Listings, Information and Applications
 - Active BMR listings page!
 - Application and lottery coming soon
- Standardized Marketing and Tenant Selection
 - RAD collaborative partner process
 - Expanding to include multifamily rentals
- Inclusionary Procedures Manual Update (March 2017)
 - Updates to include DAHLIA, Lottery Preferences, and Density Bonus legislation

Language Accessibility

- Developer training prior to lease up, including
 - Cultural Sensitivity
 - Customer Service
 - Agent orientation
- Inclusionary Manual updates to require leasing agent capacity for monolingual applicants
- BMR application and Housing Resource Guide in City languages
- Multilingual signage in leasing offices
- Increased "Secret Shopping" of lease up process

Tenant Selection

- Evictions limited to the last 2-3 years
- Denials require opportunity to present mitigating circumstances, such as:
 - "No fault" evictions
 - Escape from domestic violence
 - Enrollment in money management or payee services

Tenant Selection

- Inclusionary Manual updates to include:
 - Guarantors
 - Alternative credit
 - Minimum monthly income 2x of rent
 - Mitigating circumstances for negative credit

Tenant Selection

- Improved MOHCD internal procedures
 - Developers' rental application and lease require
 MOHCD approval
 - Fair Chance Ordinance compliance with Human Rights Commission
 - Denial tracking
 - Explicit right to appeal
 - Section 8 applicant tracking
