- 4. The sales of beer or malt beverages in quantities of 16 oz., 20 oz., 32 oz., 40 oz., or similar size containers is prohibited.
- Loitering (loitering is defined as "to stand idly about; linger aimlessly without lawful business") is prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the licensee as depicted on the ABC-257, dated 2/22/2016.
- 6. No beer or malt beverages shall be sold in quantities of less than manufacturer pre-packaged six packs per sale with the exception of wine-coolers, beer coolers which must be sold in manufacturer pre-packaged multi-unit quantities of four (4) or more.
- 7. Wine shall not be sold in bottles or containers smaller than 750 ml.
