

1 [Calling from Committee - Committee of the Whole - Planning Code Amendment (File No.
2 160252) - Construction of Accessory Dwelling Units]

3 **Motion calling from the Land Use and Transportation Committee, pursuant to Board**
4 **Rule 3.37, the proposed Ordinance (File No. 160252) amending the Planning Code to**
5 **allow for the construction of Accessory Dwelling Units (ADUs, also known as**
6 **Secondary or In-Law Units) on all lots in the City in areas that allow residential use, and**
7 **scheduling the Board of Supervisors to sit as a Committee of the Whole on**
8 **July 19, 2016, at 3:00 p.m., to hold a public hearing to consider the proposed**
9 **Ordinance.**

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11 WHEREAS, On March 15, 2016, Supervisor Aaron Peskin introduced a proposed
12 Ordinance that would amend the Planning Code to allow the construction of Accessory
13 Dwelling Units (ADUs, also known as Secondary or In-Law Units) on all lots in the City in
14 areas that allow residential use, on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File
15 No. 160252, which is hereby declared to be a part of this motion as if set forth fully herein; and

16 WHEREAS, On June 16, 2016, the San Francisco Planning Commission conducted a
17 duly noticed public hearing recommending approval of the proposed Ordinance with
18 modifications, and, on June 23, 2016, issued a formal response to that effect; and

19 WHEREAS, That proposed Ordinance (File No. 160252) is currently pending
20 committee action by the Land Use and Transportation Committee of the San Francisco Board
21 of Supervisors; now, therefore, be it

22 MOVED, That under Rule 3.37 of the San Francisco Board of Supervisors' Rules of
23 Order, the Board hereby orders the proposed Ordinance (File No. 160252) called from the
24 Land Use and Transportation Committee and returned to the full Board of Supervisors; and,

1 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors shall convene to sit as a Committee
2 of the Whole on July 19, 2016, at 3:00 p.m., to hold a public hearing to consider the proposed
3 Ordinance (File No. 160252).

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
