WHEREAS, The City has a claim against Landmark American Insurance Company and RSUI Indemnity Company (collectively "Carriers") as an additional named insured for recovery of attorney's fees and costs incurred defending third-party claims and actions arising from a City water main break that discharged water in the area of the 2600 and 2700 blocks of 15 th Avenue and the 300 and 400 blocks of Wawona Street on February 27, 2013; and

WHEREAS, The City Attorney has proposed settlement of the claim, calling for the payment of $\$ 700,000$ from the Carriers to the City; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That pursuant to Administrative Code, Section 10.24(b), the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the City Attorney to settle this unlitigated claim against the Carriers for $\$ 700,000$.
