Dear Ms. Calvillo,

Should the proposed ordinance be approved by the voters, in my opinion, it would have a minimal impact on the cost of government.

The proposed amendment would prohibit candidates in local elections from controlling a general purpose committee, which is a committee that supports or opposes more than one candidate or ballot measures. The Ethics Commission acts as the filer for, and auditor of, financial disclosure statements filed by political candidates and committees. If the proposed amendment is enacted, the Ethics Commission would add this prohibition to existing processes.
