I am pleased to inform you that the Department of Parks and Recreation, Division of Boating and Waterways (DBW) has completed its evaluation and ranking of all Non-Motorized Boat Launching Facility (NMBLF) grant applications submitted for FY2014/15 funding. The Lake Merced NMBLF project identified in the San Francisco Recreation and Park Development's application has been selected to receive a maximum of \$225,000 from the available statewide NMBLF grant funding.

The next step is to determine a mutually agreed upon scope and cost estimate for generation of the grant agreement. This agreement must be fully executed by May 1, 2015 or the funding will revert to the Harbors and Watercraft Revolving Fund and no longer be available for the purposes of this project. There is no time to spare and either I or one of my staff will be in contact with you to discuss the proposed scope and cost estimate. It is very important to note that any work completed prior to full execution of the grant agreement is not eligible for reimbursement.
