SUBJECT: LEGISLATION INTRODUCED

The Board of Supervisors' Land Use and Transportation Committee has received the following proposed legislation, introduced by the Department of Public Works on August 2, 2016:

File No. 160840

Resolution approving the street name of "Martin Avenue" for an unnamed street laying within Assessor's Parcel Block Nos. 5535 and 5557, and generally bounded by Brewster Street to the south and Mullen Avenue to the north.

The proposed legislation officially names an unnamed street, pursuant to San Francisco Public Works Code, Section 423, California Streets and Highways Code, Sections 970.5, 971, 1806, and 5026, and California Government Code, Section 34091.1.

Pursuant to the Code mandates, your department's response to this street naming is required. A hearing for this matter will be scheduled upon receipt of all required department responses.

[Official Naming of Unnamed Street - Martin Avenue]

Resolution approving the street name of "Martin Avenue" for an unnamed street laying within Assessor's Parcel Block Nos. 5535 and 5557, and generally bounded by Brewster Street to the south and Mullen Avenue to the north.

WHEREAS, The Brewster Street extension project involved Public Works construction of a portion of new unnamed roadway in Bernal Heights to be dedicated as public right-of-way in subsequent Board of Supervisors legislation; and

WHEREAS, This portion of roadway lays within City-owned property within Assessor's Parcel Block Nos. 5535 and 5557, and generally bounded by Brewster Street to the south and Mullen Avenue to the north; and

WHEREAS, This unnamed roadway is shown on Public Works Drawing Q-20-554, a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No.

and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, In Public Works ("PW") Order No. 170,937, dated March 11, 1998, the City Engineer certified that: (a) all work on this segment of roadway has been inspected, (b) the work was complete as of March 9th, 1998, as evidenced by a PW Certificate of Completion, (c) the road has been constructed in accordance with the Plans and Specifications and all City codes, regulations, standards, and (d) such improvements are ready for their intended use; and

WHEREAS, A copy of this PW Order is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. ______ and is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors will dedicate this roadway as open public rightof-way in a subsequent action; and

Public Works BOARD OF SUPERVISORS WHEREAS, For establishing the name of unnamed streets, the City follows the general practices specified in Public Works Code, Section 423, the PW's informational bulletin entitled "Street Name Establishment/Street Name Change, California Street and Highways Code, Sections 970.5, 971, 1806, and 5026, and California Government Code, Section 34091.1; and

WHEREAS, The roadway name, Martin Avenue, is in honor of Martin Ron, a wellknown professional land surveyor whose love of the art and science of land surveying and admiration for his adopted city inspired him to dedicate his career to achieving expertise in San Francisco land surveying; and

WHEREAS, In 1968, Mr. Ron founded his own firm, Martin M. Ron Associates, Inc., in downtown San Francisco, and since that time his firm performed professional surveying services on almost every major project in the City; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That consistent with laws and procedures specified above, the Board of Supervisors hereby establishes the name for the unnamed roadway within Assessor's Parcel Block Nos. 5535 and 5557, and generally bounded by Brewster Street to the south and Mullen Avenue to the north, as "Martin Avenue"; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That by adopting this legislation, the Board of Supervisors does not intend to effectuate any change in City department jurisdictional control over any portion of the street to be known as Martin Avenue; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors directs the Clerk of the Board to forward a certified copy of this resolution to the County Surveyor in accordance with California Streets and Highways Code, Section 5026 in order to enter the name on the official records of San Francisco street names; and, be it

Public Works BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors directs the Municipal Transportation Agency to erect street signs with the name Martin Avenue in accordance with the general terms of Transportation Code Article 2, Section 2.2.
