Resolution supporting the San Francisco Unified School District Resolution

No. 166-14Sp1, a \$744,250,000 facilities bond to repair and rehabilitate San Francisco

Unified School District facilities to current accessibility, health, safety, seismic, and
instructional standards, renovate outdated classrooms and training facilities, construct
school facilities, replace aging classrooms, and improve information technology
systems and food service preparation systems.

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Unified School District will ask City voters to approve a \$744,000,000 facilities bond in the November 2016 election; and

WHEREAS, If approved by 55% of votes cast, the School Bond may permit construction of new schools, an arts center and improvements to existing school sites; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Unified School District would spend a majority of the bond funds—\$409,000,000—on building construction and renovations, including seismic upgrades, corrections to health and safety risks and computer technology improvements; and

WHEREAS, Up to \$100,000,000 of bond proceeds may be used to renovate, reconstruct and construct facilities at 135 Van ness Avenue/170 Fell Streets for use as the District Arts Center; and

WHEREAS, \$20,000,000 of the bond may support modernizing school kitchens for Student Nutrition and Food Service Delivery; and

WHEREAS, The proposed school bond may use up to \$5,000,000 to contribute, as permitted by law, to the construction of below-market-rate housing for educators; and

WHEREAS, The District may use bond proceeds to continue supporting Green Schoolyards, an outdoor learning environment for students; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby supports San Francisco Unified School District Resolution Ordering School Bond Election in an Amount Not to Exceed \$744,250,000.
