WHEREAS. The City and County of San Francisco Board of Supervisors is taking a stand to save lives by supporting the California Healthcare. Research and Prevention Tobacco Tax Act of 2016 on the November 2016 ballot; and

WHEREAS, Smoking is the leading preventable cause of death in California; and WHEREAS, 90 percent of smokers start as teenagers and over 16,000 children in California get hooked on smoking every year, and half of the teens who start will die from smoking related illness; and

WHEREAS, Tobacco is responsible for about one of every seven deaths, or 14%, in San Francisco; and

WHEREAS: For every 10 percent increase in the cost of a pack of cigarettes, teen smoking drops by up to 6.5%; and

WHEREAS, Teen e-cigarette use tripled between 2013 and 2014; and

WHEREAS, Every year, smoking costs California taxpayers billions of dollars, including \$3.5 billion spent annually on Medi-Cal to treat smoking-related diseases; and

WHEREAS, The California Healthcare, Research and Prevention Tobacco Tax Act of 2016 will reduce smoking rates and long-term healthcare costs; and

WHEREAS, The California Healthcare, Research and Prevention Tobacco Tax Act of 2016 will fund healthcare programs through the Department of Health Care Services-including Medi-Cal, smoking prevention programs administered by the California Department of Public

Health Tobacco Control Program and the Department of Education, and medical research on tobacco-related diseases including cancer, heart and lung disease through the University of California; and

WHEREAS, The California Healthcare, Research and Prevention Tobacco Tax Act of 2016 will increase the tax on a pack of cigarettes sold in California from 87 cents a pack to \$2.87, and place equivalent taxes on other tobacco products containing nicotine, like e-cigarettes; and

WHEREAS, Californians must stand together against Big Tobacco to save lives and help smokers quit; and

WHEREAS, The California Healthcare, Research and Prevention Tax Act of 2016 is supported by the American Cancer Society Cancer Action Network, the American Heart Association, the American Lung Association in California, Blue Shield of California, the California Medical Association, the California Dental Association, the California Hospital Association, and the Service Employees International Union; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That City and County of San Francisco Board of Supervisors strongly supports the California Healthcare, Research and Prevention Tobacco Tax of 2016 to take a stand to save lives and help smokers quit; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco directs the Clerk of the Board to communicate this resolution to California State Legislators.
