ALU Recommendation: Approval with the following conditions:

- 1. There shall be no cups, glasses, or similar receptacles commonly used for the drinking of beverages, sold, furnished, or given away at the petitioner(s) premises in quantities of less than twenty-four (24) in their original multi-container package
- 2. The sale of beer or malt beverage(s) with an alcoholic content greater than 5.7% by volume is prohibited.
- 3. The sale of distilled spirits in sizes smaller than 200ml is strictly prohibited.
- 4. The sales of beer or malt beverages in quantities of quantities of 16oz, 32 oz., 40 oz., size containers is prohibited
- 5. Wine coolers shall only be sold in manufacturer pre-packaged multi-unit quantities of four (4) or more
- 6. No wine shall be sold with an alcohol content of greater than 15% by volume except for "Dinner Wines" which have been aged two years or more and maintained in corked bottles
- Loitering (loitering is defined as "to stand idly about; linger aimlessly without lawful business") is prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the licensee as depicted on the ABC 257 dated 3-18-16.
- 8. The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which they have control.
- 9. Sales, and service of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 12:00 a.m. daily
- 10. Graffiti shall be removed from the premises and all parking lots under the control of the licensee within 72 hours of application. If the graffiti occurs on a Friday or weekend day, or on a holiday, the licensee shall remove the graffiti within 72 hours following the beginning of the next weekday
