9	WHEREAS, Metropolitan Transportation Commission awarded San Francisco		
10	Department of Public Health in the amount of \$1,439,000 for the San Francisco Safe Routes		
11	to School Program for the period of September 1, 2014, through August 31, 2017; and		
12	WHEREAS, On October 22, 2013, the Board of Supervisors approved and authorized		
13	to accept and expend these funds, a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of		
14	Supervisors in File No. 130890; and		
15	WHEREAS, Metropolitan Transportation Commission awarded San Francisco		
16	Department of Public Health an additional funding of \$360,000 for the San Francisco Safe		
17	Routes to School Program for the period of October 1, 2016, though August 31, 2017; and		
18	WHEREAS, The full project period of the grant starts on September 1, 2014, and ends		
19	on August 31, 2017, with additional funding for the period of October 1, 2016, through August		
20	31, 2017; and		
21	WHEREAS, The purpose of this additional funding is to expand the following: San		
22	Francisco Safe Routes to School communication and evaluation, parent/caregiver outreach,		
23	San Francisco Safe Routes to School assemblies on pedestrian and bike safety, hands-on		
24	bike education to middle schools, reach of Walk and Roll to School Day 2016, reach of school		
25	transportation toolkits, and annual school commute study to school year 2016-2017; and

10	indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it	
11	FURTHER RESOLVED, That San Francisco Department of Public Health is hereby	
12	authorized to retroactively accept and expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco	
13	Administrative Code, Section 10.170-1; and, be it	
14	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the	
15	agreement on behalf of the City.
