



•CCSF contributes \$19.2 million to Museum operations for FY 2016-17

Subject to open meeting laws

Trustees required to file certain <u>public disclosures</u>

•Self-perpetuating Board with the exception of two ex-officio positions, the Mayor and the President of the Recreation and Parks Commission

•May have up to 62 elected Trustees. Current number is 50.

## The Fine Arts Museums Foundation (FAMF)

•Private 501(c)3 organization

•Guiding document:

Bylaws of the Fine Arts Museums Foundation

•Formed for the educational purpose of receiving, donating and otherwise disbursing funds for the embellishment, advancement, administration and enlargement of the Fine Arts Museums of San Francisco

•Museums' Endowment funds are held by the Foundation. Contributes about \$2 million in operating funds to COFAM. In FY 14-15, contributed \$2 million for art acquisitions

Self-perpetuating Board

•May have up to 17 elected Trustees. Current number is 9.

## **Corporation of the Fine Arts Museums (COFAM)**

Private 501(c)3 organization

•Guiding documents:

•Bylaws of the Corporation of the Fine Arts Museums

•Primary purpose is to support, aid, promote, operate in conjunction with, and supplement the activities of the Fine Arts Museums of San Francisco

•Contributes \$46 million to Museum operations

Self-perpetuating Board

•May have up to 75 elected Trustees. Current number is 50.





