3	Motion appointing Jennifer Garcia (residency requirement waived), term ending August
4	31, 2017, to the Cannabis State Legalization Task Force.

6	MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does
7	hereby appoint the hereinafter designated person to serve as a member of the Cannabis
8	State Legalization Task Force, pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Code, Article II,
9	Sections 5.2-1 through 5.2-7, for the terms specified:
10	Jennifer Garcla (residency requirement waived), Seat 20, succeeding themself, term
11	expired, must be a representative of a labor union that represents employees working in the
12	cannabis industry, for a one-year term ending August 31, 2017.
13	FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:
14	1. The membership of the Cannabis State Legalization Task Force has a goal to be
15	representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
16	2. Applicant Jennifer Garcia, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a person with
17	experience that uniquely qualifies her to serve on the Cannabis State Legalization Task
18	Force.
19	3. The Cannabis State Legalization Task Force has attempted to fill the position, for which
20	Jennifer Garcla was nominated, with an individual who is a City resident and who has
21	the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this
22	time. The Rules Committee has certified that Jennifer Garcia is qualified to serve on
23	the Cannabis State Legalization Task Force.
24	4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no
25	other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco, and who has the

Board Qualifications:

The Cannabis State Legalization Task Force (Task Force) was established to advise the Board of Supervisors, the Mayor, and other City departments on matters relating to the potential legalization of cannabis so that the policymakers are fully prepared to address policy questions through legislation and administrative actions, following the adoption of a State law.

The Task Force consists of 22 members (seats 1 through 7 shall be non-voting members):

DEPARTMENT HEAD MEMBERS

- > Seat 1: Director of the Department of Public Health, or his/her designee
- > Seat 2: Chief of the Fire Department, or his/her designee
- > Seat 3: Chief of the Police Department, his/her designee
- > Seat 4: Director of the Department of Building Inspection, or his/her designee
- > Seat 5: Director of Planning, or his/her designee

> Seat 6: Executive Director of the Entertainment Commission, or his/her designee

> Seat 7: Executive Director of the California Board of Equalization, or his/her designee (if the Executive Director declines and fails to appoint a designee for 60 days or longer, the Board of Supervisors may appoint a member of the public)

> Seat 8: Superintendent of the San Francisco Unified School District, or his/her designee which may include a Member of the Board of Education (if the Superintendent declines and fails to appoint a designee for 60 days or longer, the Board of Supervisors may appoint a member of the public)

> Seat 15: Must be an individual with experience working to advance the tourism or hospitality industry in San Francisco.

> Seats 16 and 17: Must be individuals who represent neighborhood associations.

> Seat 18: Must be an individual with experience in public health advocacy focusing on drug policy.

> Seat 19: Must be an individual working in the entertainment or nightlife industry.

> Seat 20: Must be a representative of a labor union that represents employees working in the cannabis industry.

> Seat 21: Must be a public policy expert working for an organization focused on the formulation of good public policy.

> Seat 22: Must be an individual between the ages of 21 and 30 at the time of appointment.

The Public Members in seats 9 through 22 shall serve for a term of one year. The initial term for each seat shall begin on August 31, 2015. At the end of the one-year term, the Board of Supervisors may reappoint the member by written motion without soliciting applications from additional applicants.

The Department of Public Health shall provide clerical and administrative support and staffing for the Task Force. The Task Force shall hold a regular meeting not less than five times per year.

Annual Report: No later than one year after its inaugural meeting, and at least once in the 12 months thereafter, the Task Force shall submit a report to the Board of Supervisors describing the legislative activity in the State Legislature regarding possible legalization of cannabis; findings regarding legal, social, land use, and enforcement issues that are likely to arise in San Francisco if the State adopts proposed legislation through the legislative or electoral process; and recommendations regarding local implementation and enforcement of that potential legislation.
