

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[Settlement of Lawsuit and Supplemental Appropriation - Theodore A. Bowie, II - \$500,000]

ORDINANCE INO.

Ordinance authorizing settlement of the lawsuit filed by Theodore A. Bowie, II against the City and County of San Francisco for \$500,000; the lawsuit was filed on October 17, 2014, in San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-14-542235; entitled <u>Theodore A.</u> <u>Bowie, II v. City and County of San Francisco, et al.</u>; the lawsuit involves alleged property damage arising from the break of the Public Utilities Commission's water transmission pipeline on 15th Avenue between West Portal Avenue and Wawona Street in San Francisco; and appropriating \$500,000 from the Water Enterprise fund balance for such purpose.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Pursuant to Charter, Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the City Attorney to settle the action entitled <u>Theodore A. Bowie, II v. City and</u> <u>County of San Francisco, et al.</u>, San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-14-542235 by the payment of \$500,000. The lawsuit involves alleged property damage from the break of the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission's (SFPUC) water transmission pipeline on 15th Avenue between West Portal Avenue and Wawona Avenue in San Francisco.

Section 2. The above-named action was filed in San Francisco Superior Court on October 17, 2014, and the following parties were named in the lawsuit: Plaintiff: Theodore A. Bowie, II; Defendants: City and County of San Francisco and Precision Engineering, Inc.

Section 3. The Board herein appropriates \$500,000 from the Water Enterprise fund balance for use by the SFPUC for purposes of settling the litigation.
