Ordinance authorizing settlement of the lawsuit filed by the City and County of San Francisco against In and Out Drain Cleaning, Inc. for \$38,500; the lawsuit was filed on March 24, 2015, in San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-15-544912; entitled <u>City and County of San Francisco v.
