- 4) No wine shall be sold with an alcoholic content of greater than 15% by volume except for "Dinner Wines" which have been aged two years or more and maintained in corked bottles
- 5) Wine shall not be sold in bottles or containers smaller than 750 ml.
- 6) Loitering (loitering is defined as "to stand idly about; linger aimlessly without lawful business") is prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the licensee as depicted on the ABC-257, dated _____.
- 7) Sales and service of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. daily.

It should be noted that the applicant has agreed with the above listed recommended conditions.




