Resolution determining that the transfer of a Type 21 off-sale general license to Trader Joe's Company, dba Trader Joe's 225, located at 10-4<sup>th</sup> Street, Basement LVL (District 6), will serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and County of San Francisco, in accordance with California Business and Professions Code, Section 23958.4, and recommending that the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control impose conditions on the issuance of the license.

WHEREAS, Trader Joe's Company is seeking the transfer of a Type 21 off-sale general license dba Trader Joe's 225 located at 10-4<sup>th</sup> Street, Basement LVL (District 6); and

WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly zoned and recommends approval; and

WHEREAS, The Police Department has filed two (2) protests with the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control under California Business and Professions Code, Section 24013, and recommends that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control issue the liquor license with conditions; and






After surveying the area around the proposed Trader Joes store location and talking with both security, nearby residents and merchants about the effects a large chain store would have in retailing any forms of liquor to the public in the manner of a off-sale license.

Nearby merchants express the lower price point the a large retailer can sell their liquor at which would take away customers of already existing smaller established community serving stores. Local residents have the same concerns that a retailer such as Trader Joes can offer lower priced liquor which nearby already established licensed stored would have a hard time competing against. There is a strong support of local retailers to stay in business and to maintain their existing stores and customer base. We do not want to see more smaller stores closing because of their lose of revenue.

The main concern residents and security have is enforcing and protecting the already established San Francisco Park Code for nearby Yerba Buena Gardens and BART Station. This code specially mentions smoking and alcoholic beverages which are intended to be sold by Trader Joes. Additional concerns by security is the drain on public resources in dealing with shoplifters. The San Francisco Police Department continues to shrink in the number of officers. And San Francisco continues to increase in population bringing more security tasks to perform with fewer police officers.

The next concern is Yerba Buena Gardens itself. Open Space with the following consideration points Ice Skating Center, Play Circle, Bowling Center, Child Development Center, and Carousel; several adjacent parking garages and facilities; and St. Patrick's Church. Include student aged College Campuses other educational programs, MUNI & BART Station access.

Issuance of the license to the premises would add an undue concentration of licenses; licensing the premises aggravates an already existing police problems in a high-crime area; and the premises is within 500 feet of open space.

I do not know what the security plan for the new store is nor do I know which exits will be used by the public.

Because of the above concerns the following conditions must be applied.

Employees of the establishment shall walk a 100 feet radius from the premises sometime between 30 minutes after closing time and 8AM the following morning and shall pick up and dispose of any discarded beverage containers and other trash left by patrons.

The establishment shall provide outside lighting in a manner sufficient to illuminate street and adjacent sidewalk areas and parking as appropriate to maintain security.

No alcoholic beverages shall be consumed on any outdoor property adjacent to the establishment.

No person under the age of 21 shall sell or package alcoholic beverages.

Employees of the establishment shall regularly police the area under the control of the establishment in an effort to prevent the loitering of persons about the premises.

The establishment shall promptly remove any graffiti from the exterior of the premises.

Sales of Alcohol only permitted between the hours of 8AM to 10PM 7 days a week.

No fortified wines or hard liquor can be sold.

No malt liquor bottles or cans.

Sell single containers of alcoholic beverage in clear plastic carry-out bags.

Beer & Wine must be sold in manufactured pre-packed multi-unit quantities only.
