# Conditions for Type 21 (Off-Sale General Public), 86 (Instructional Tasting)

- 1. Sales of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. daily.
- 2. Loitering (loitering is defined as "to stand idly about; linger aimlessly without lawful business") is prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the licensee as depicted on the ABC-257, dated
- 3. No noise shall be audible beyond the area under the control of the licensee as defined on the ABC-257, dated
- 4. The sale of distilled spirits in sizes smaller than 200 ml is strictly prohibited.

It should be noted that the applicant has agreed to the above listed conditions.
