

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Centers for Disease Control and Prevention - Enhancing Health  
2 Resilience to Climate Change Through Adaptation - \$213,713]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Department of Public Health to accept and**  
4 **expend a grant in the amount of \$213,713 from Centers for Disease Control and**  
5 **Prevention to participate in a program entitled, Enhancing Health Resilience to Climate**  
6 **Change Through Adaptation for the period of September 1, 2016, through August 31,**  
7 **2017.**

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9 WHEREAS, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention has agreed to fund  
10 Department of Public Health (DPH) in the amount of \$213,713 for the period of September 1,  
11 2016, through August 31, 2017; and

12 WHEREAS, The full project period of the grant starts on September 1, 2016, and ends  
13 on August 31, 2021, with years two, three, four, and five subject to availability of funds and  
14 satisfactory progress of the project; and

15 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, Centers for Disease Control  
16 and Prevention requires the City to enter into an agreement (Agreement), a copy of which is  
17 on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 161292; which is hereby declared  
18 to be a part of this Resolution as if set forth fully herein; and

19 WHEREAS, The purpose of this project is to work with City and community  
20 stakeholders to plan, implement, monitor, evaluate, and continuously improve climate and  
21 health interventions as identified in the Department of Public Health Climate and Health  
22 Adaptation Plan; and

23 WHEREAS, This initiative will implement a Climate and Health Adaptation and  
24 Monitoring Program for San Francisco through engaging stakeholders in climate resilience  
25 and working with vulnerable populations; and

1           WHEREAS, The budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of  
2 \$19,448; now, therefore, be it

3           RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant  
4 in the amount of \$213,713 from Centers for Disease Control and Prevention; and, be it

5           FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and  
6 expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code, Section 10.170-1;  
7 and, be it

8           FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the  
9 Agreement on behalf of the City.
