My name is Robert Uy and I am a partner at Uy Law Group. I am a director of the Asian American Bar Association of the Greater Bay Area (San Francisco organization), an advisory board member and former President of the Filipino Bar Association of the Greater Bay Area (San Francisco organization) and former regional governor of the National Filipino American Lawyers Association.
