Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1.

(a) The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this ordinance comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public Resources Code Sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 161195 and is incorporated herein by reference. The Board affirms this determination.

(b) On ______, the Planning Department determined that the actions contemplated in this ordinance are consistent, on balance, with the City's General Plan and eight priority policies of Planning Code Section 101.1. The Board adopts this determination as its own. A copy of said determination is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. ______, and is incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. Findings.

(a) Alex Nieto was shot and killed by San Francisco Police Department officers on March 21, 2014 in Bernal Heights Park.

(b) Alex Nieto was born and raised in the Bernal Heights and Mission neighborhoods, and was a widely known and loved member of those communities.

(c) The community strongly desires to memorialize the life of Alex Nieto and mark the spot of his tragic death.

(d) Many see the Alex Nieto memorial as a way to repair harm done to the neighborhood and bring a sense of justice and healing.

Section 3. Commemoration of Alex Nieto.

The Board of Supervisors directs the Recreation and Park Department, after a community process open to residents of the Bernal Heights neighborhood and to other interested persons, and subject to Civic Design Review by the Arts Commission, to install a memorial on Bernal Heights Park in honor of Alex Nieto. The memorial shall be located along the paved pathway on the northern side of Bernal Hill. <u>The maintenance and upkeep of the memorial shall be the responsibility of the Recreation and Park Department.</u>

Section 4. Requested Official Actions.

The Board of Supervisors directs the Recreation and Park Commission and Recreation and Park Department to take all actions necessary to implement the intent of this Ordinance, including approval of the installation of the memorial.

Section 5. Fee Waiver.

Notwithstanding any contrary provision of the Municipal Code, all permit and inspection and review fees associated with the installation of the memorial shall be waived.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the

ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

Ordinance directing the Recreation and Park Department to install in Bernal Heights Park a memorial in honor of Alex Nieto; directing official acts in furtherance of this Ordinance; waiving permit and inspection fees for the installation; and affirming the Planning Department's determination under the California Environmental Quality Act.

Existing Law

Bernal Heights Park is under the jurisdiction of the Recreation and Park Commission.

Amendments to Current Law

This is an uncodified ordinance.

Background Information

Alex Nieto was born and raised in the Bernal Heights and Mission neighborhoods and died after being shot by San Francisco Police Department officers on March 21, 2014 in Bernal Heights Park. The legislation directs the Recreation and Park Department, after a community process open to residents of the Bernal Heights neighborhood and to other interested persons, and subject to Civic Design Review by the Arts Commission, to install a memorial on Bernal Heights Park in honor of Alex Nieto. The memorial shall be located along the paved pathway on the northern side of Bernal Hill. All permit and inspection and review fees associated with the installation of the memorial will be waived. After installation, the Recreation and Park Department will be responsible for maintaining the memorial.

This legislative digest reflects amendments adopted by the Public Safety and Neighborhood Services Committee on December 1, 2016.
