

1 [Contract Amendment - AdvanTel Networks - \$15,000,000]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the Office of Contract Administration to enter into the Fourth**
4 **Amendment of the contract agreement between the City and County of San Francisco**
5 **and AdvanTel Networks, to increase the contract limit from \$9,900,000 to \$15,000,000**
6 **for the period of October 13, 2011, through September 30, 2018.**

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8 WHEREAS, The Office of Contract Administration, by competitive bidding, entered
9 into a Term Contract with AdvanTel Networks for the supply of Avaya phone equipment and
10 related services; and

11 WHEREAS, The original contract with AdvanTel Networks, Inc. dated
12 October 13, 2011, had a term of three years through September 30, 2014, with options to
13 extend the term through mutual agreement between the contracting parties; and

14 WHEREAS, The Purchaser approved the First Amendment on September 23, 2014,
15 to extend the contract term by one year; and

16 WHEREAS, The Purchaser approved the Second Amendment on August 24, 2015,
17 to extend the contract term by one year; and

18 WHEREAS, The Purchaser approved the Third Amendment on September 28, 2016,
19 to extend the contract term by one year; and

20 WHEREAS, The Office of Contract Administration estimates that the money
21 projected to be spent with AdvanTel Networks could reach the contract's limit in the
22 reasonably near future; and

23 WHEREAS, Charter, Section 9.118(b) "Contract and Lease Limitations," requires the
24 Board of Supervisors to approve any contract estimated to exceed \$10,000,000 in
25 expenditures or amendments exceeding \$500,000 to such contracts; now, therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Purchaser and the Director
2 of the Office of Contract Administration to enter into the Fourth Amendment to the contract
3 with AdvanTel Networks in substantially the form attached to increase the contract limit from
4 \$9,900,000 to \$15,000,000; and, be it

5 FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the Fourth Amendment being
6 fully executed by all parties, the Office of Contract Administration shall provide the final Fourth
7 Amendment to the Clerk of the Board for inclusion into the official file.

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
