

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Public Health Foundation Enterprises, Inc. - Epidemiology and  
2 Laboratory Capacity Gonorrhoea Rapid Detection and Response Project- \$598,052.66]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Department of Public Health to accept and**  
4 **expend a grant in the amount of \$598,052.66 from Public Health Foundation**  
5 **Enterprises, Inc., to participate in a program entitled Epidemiology and Laboratory**  
6 **Capacity Gonorrhoea Rapid Detection and Response Project for the period of**  
7 **August 1, 2016, through July 31, 2017.**

9 WHEREAS, Public Health Foundation Enterprises, Inc. is the recipient of a grant award  
10 from Centers for Disease Control and Prevention supporting the Epidemiology and Laboratory  
11 Capacity Gonorrhoea Rapid Detection and Response Project grant; and

12 WHEREAS, With a portion of these funds, Public Health Foundation Enterprises, Inc.  
13 has subcontracted with San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) in the amount  
14 of \$598,052.66 for the period of August 1, 2016, through July 31, 2017; and

15 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, Public Health Foundation  
16 Enterprises, Inc. requires the City to enter into an agreement (Agreement), a copy of which is  
17 on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 170104; which is hereby declared  
18 to be a part of this Resolution as if set forth fully herein; and

19 WHEREAS, The purpose of this project will support, expand, and accelerate efforts to  
20 combat antibiotic-resistant Neisseria gonorrhoeae (ARG) in San Francisco by developing and  
21 implementing protocols for rapid identification and response to ARG cases, expanding  
22 surveillance to additional clinic sites, populations including females and youth, and anatomic  
23 sites of infection, and collaborating throughout the surrounding Bay Area region to provide  
24 comprehensive rapid response to ARG cases; and

1           WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH did not  
2 receive notification of the award until October 26, 2016, for a project start date of  
3 August 1, 2016; and

4           WHEREAS, The budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount  
5 of \$99,866.13; now, therefore, be it

6           RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby retroactively authorized to accept and expend a grant  
7 in the amount of \$598,052.66 from Public Health Foundation Enterprises, Inc.; and

8           FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and  
9 expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and,  
10 be it

11           FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the  
12 Agreement on behalf of the City.
