

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Public Health Foundation Enterprises, Inc. - MAC AIDS Getting to
2 Zero Program - \$137,260]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Department of Public Health to accept and**
4 **expend a grant in the amount of \$137,260 from Public Health Foundation Enterprises,**
5 **Inc. to participate in a program entitled MAC AIDS Getting to Zero for the period of**
6 **July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017.**

8 WHEREAS, Public Health Foundation Enterprises, Inc. is the recipient of a grant award
9 from MAC AIDS Fund supporting the MAC AIDS Getting to Zero grant; and

10 WHEREAS, With a portion of these funds, Public Health Foundation Enterprises has
11 subcontracted with San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) in the amount
12 of \$137,260 for the period of July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017; and

13 WHEREAS, The purpose of this project is to oversee all components of the Linkage,
14 Integration, Navigation, and Comprehensive Services (LINCS) Navigation team including
15 project hiring, training, implementation, data management and program evaluation; and

16 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance Amendment; and

17 WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH received
18 the letter of funding allocation on September 29, 2016, for a project start date of July 1, 2016;
19 and

20 WHEREAS, The budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount
21 of \$24,896; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant
23 in the amount of \$137,260 from Public Health Foundation Enterprises; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby retroactively authorized to accept and
2 expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code, Section 10.170-1;
3 and, be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
5 Agreement on behalf of the City.
