11	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
12	
13	Section 1. Article 4.2 of the Public Works Code is hereby amended by revising Section
14	146.10 to read as follows:
15	SEC. 146.10. ENFORCEMENT.
16	Persons violating any provision of the Construction Site Runoff Control Permit or
17	Sections 146 – 146.11 of this Article or applicable laws or regulations are subject to
18	enforcement by the General Manager pursuant to Section 132 of Article 4.1 of this Code.
19	Persons violating Sections 146 – 146.11 of Article 4.2 or applicable laws or regulations are
20	subject to penalties and abatement in accordance with Sections 133 and 134 of Article 4.1 of
21	this Code, and any other remedies allowed by law. For construction projects in areas of the City
22	under the jurisdiction of the Port Commission, the Port's Executive Director or his or her designee
23	shall have enforcement authority identical to the enforcement authority referenced in the two preceding
24	sentences.
25	

1	Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
2	enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
3	ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
4	of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
5	Section 3. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors
6	intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,
7	numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal
8	Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment
9	additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under
10	the official title of the ordinance.
