[Contract Agreement - Global Tel*Link - Inmate Telephone Services - Anticipated Revenue of More Than \$1,000,000]

Resolution retroactively authorizing the Sheriff's Department to contract with Global Tel*Link to provide Inmate Telephone Services, which will memorialize inmate phone call rates that reduce the cost of the average local call by 34%, and will result in an anticipated revenue to the Inmate Welfare Fund of more than \$1,000,000 over the threeyear contract term of December 1, 2016, through November 30, 2019, and authorizing the Sheriff to exercise the agreement's two one-year options to extend the term for a total term not to exceed five years.

WHEREAS, San Francisco Charter, Section 9.118, requires that contracts entered into by a department, board or commission having anticipated revenue of one million dollars or more shall be subject to approval of the Board of Supervisors by resolution; and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff's Department, held a competitive bid process RFP SHF2015-01 for Inmate Telephone Services; and

WHEREAS, A three member panel evaluated and scored the written proposals in accordance with the City approved selection criteria; and

WHEREAS, The Contract Monitoring Division determined 14B subcontracting goals do not apply; and

WHEREAS, The three member panel determined that Global Tel*Link is the best responsive and responsible proposer; and

WHEREAS, The proposed contract agreement with Global Tel*Link to provide inmate telephone services ("Agreement") is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File

Sheriff's Department BOARD OF SUPERVISORS No. 170050, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as set forth fully herein; and

WHEREAS, The FCC released an order to reform inmate calling rates and fees; and WHEREAS, The FCC 2015 Order required jails to implement debit/pre-paid and collect calling rate caps of \$0.14 and \$0.49 respectively on all call types and to remove surcharge fees; and

WHEREAS, the FCC 2015 Order regarding debit/pre-paid and collect calling rate caps was stayed, leaving only the FCC 2013 Order of Interstate calling rate caps of \$0.21 and \$0.25 in place; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Sheriff negotiated inmate call charge rates for Collect, Pre-Paid Collect, and Pre-Paid Cards of \$0.14 per minute for Local calls and \$0.18 per minute for Intralata, Interlata, and Interstate calls, and eliminating all surcharges GTL-initiated inmate telephone calls, and reducing the pre-paid collect fees; and

WHEREAS, The cost for an average 11-minute Local call is reduced from \$2.35, per the prior contract amendment, to \$1.54; and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff's Department has an Inmate Welfare Fund, as provided for in California Penal Code, Section 5000-5030.1; and

WHEREAS, The Agreement provides that Global Tel*Link shall pay to the Sheriff's Inmate Welfare Fund a tiered commission of 20 to 55% based on gross revenue sales; and

WHEREAS, The Agreement provides that Global Tel*Link shall pay to the Sheriff's Inmate Welfare Fund an additional five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) payable thirty days from contract execution; and

WHEREAS, The Agreement provides that Global Tel*Link shall pay to the Sheriff's Inmate Welfare Fund a Cost Reimbursement Payment of one thousand two hundred dollars (\$1,200) per month; and

1	WHEREAS, The Agreement has a three-year term beginning December 1, 2016; and
2	WHEREAS, The Agreement provides that the City has two options to renew the
3	agreement for a period of one year each, which the City may exercise at the City's sole and
4	absolute discretion; now, therefore be it
5	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the Agreement on file
6	with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 170050; and, be it
7	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Sheriff is authorized to exercise the Agreement's two
8	one-year options to extend the term for a total term not to exceed five years.
