WHEREAS, Galindo Installation and Moving Services (GIMS) has offered to donate furniture valued at \$18,770 to the San Francisco Police Department, including 25 two-tier lockers valued at \$265 per locker, eight storage shelving valued at \$295 per unit, one conference table valued at \$895, four wardrobe storage cabinets valued at \$675 per cabinet, three cabinets valued at \$780 per cabinet, and 22 office chairs valued at \$175 per chair; and

WHEREAS, The stations and areas that can directly benefit from this donation are: the Hall of Justice, Tenderloin, Richmond, Northern, and Central Station office spaces; the Taraval and Park Station report writing areas; the Range offices; the Academy (lockers); and the crime lab and photo ID areas (steel shelving); and

WHEREAS, Accepting this donation from Galindo Installation and Moving Services (GIMS) will further the City's Zero Waste Program by reusing furniture that otherwise will be discarded; and

WHEREAS, This furniture will allow for the department's Fiscal Division and Facilities
Unit to allocate budget specifically to incremental furniture replacement over a seven year
