

1 [Accept and Expend Gift - San Francisco General Hospital Foundation - Public
2 Health/Community Outreach Campaign - \$664,567]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Department of Public Health to accept and**
4 **expend a gift in the amount of \$664,567 from the San Francisco General Hospital**
5 **Foundation, to participate in a program entitled Public Health/Community Outreach**
6 **Campaign for the period of February 1, 2017, through January 31, 2019, waiving**
7 **indirect costs.**

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9 WHEREAS, San Francisco General Hospital Foundation is the recipient of
10 \$75,000,000 gift from Priscilla Chan and Mark Zuckerberg; and

11 WHEREAS, With a portion of these funds, \$8,000,000 is being funded for the Public
12 Health/Community Outreach campaign; and

13 WHEREAS, With a portion of \$8,000,000, San Francisco General Hospital Foundation
14 made a bequest of \$664,567 to San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) for the
15 period of February 1, 2017, through January 31, 2019; and

16 WHEREAS, The purpose of this gift will be used to improve the hospital's ability to
17 attract and retain patients, and for patients to understand that the hospital is part of the San
18 Francisco Health Network, with a comprehensive array of services available to them; and

19 WHEREAS, An Annual Salary Ordinance Amendment is not required; and

20 WHEREAS, Public Health/Community Outreach Campaign project does not allow for
21 indirect costs to maximize use of gift funds on direct services; and

22 WHEREAS, The gift terms prohibit including indirect costs in the gift budget; now,
23 therefore, be it

24 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend a gift in the amount
25 of \$664,567 from San Francisco General Hospital Foundation; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
2 indirect costs in the gift budget; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the distribution from the San Francisco General Hospital
4 Foundation shall be accepted and expended consistent with San Francisco Administrative
5 Code Sections governing the acceptance of gifts, donations, and contributions.
