16	WHEREAS, The purpose of this gift will be used to improve the hospital's ability to	
17	attract and retain patients, and for patients to understand that the hospital is part of the San	
18	Francisco Health Network, with a comprehensive array of services available to them; and	
19	WHEREAS, An Annual Salary Ordinance Amendment is not required; and	
20	WHEREAS, Public Health/Community Outreach Campaign project does not allow for	
21	indirect costs to maximize use of gift funds on direct services; and	
22	WHEREAS, The gift terms prohibit including indirect costs in the gift budget; now,

24	RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend a gift in the amount	
25	of \$664,567 from San Francisco General Hospital Foundation; and, be it

3	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the distribution from the San Francisco General Hospit

5	Code Sections governing the acceptance of gifts, donations, and contributions.
