Resolution calling for the City and County of San Francisco to support Internationa
Worker's Day and "A Day Without An Immigrant" on May 1, 2017.

[Supporting International Worker's Day and "A Day Without an Immigrant" - May 1, 2017]

WHEREAS. The Trump administration has wasted no time in fulfilling Trump's bigoted campaign promises by attacking immigrants, refugees, and Muslims with travel bans and ICE raids, and building the wall between Mexico and the United States; and

WHEREAS. Millions of youth and working people across the nation have vigorously protested the President's policies, with the Women's March on the first day of his presidency being the largest demonstrations in U.S. history; and

WHEREAS, Labor unions in San Francisco have been critical in the fight for worker rights, minimum and living wages, affordable housing, eight hour work days, and paid sick days; and

WHEREAS, Labor unions, a prime target of the right wing, face the constant threat of union-busting Right to Work legislation, which is being considered by a Republican controlled U.S. Congress, and public sector unions could soon see a U.S. Supreme Court ruling that would decimate their collective bargaining rights; and

WHEREAS, The right wing agenda has long included breaking labor unions, gutting the social safety net, privatizing public education, eviscerating environmental laws, deregulating banking and other industries, militarizing the police, waging an endless war, and weakening civil rights protections, and Trump's Cabinet appointees indicate that they plan to follow this reactionary agenda; and

WHEREAS, National immigrant rights organizations are calling for "A Day Without an Immigrant" national actions on May 1, 2017; and

The San Francisco Board of Supervisors encourages departments and employees of the City and County of San Francisco to participate in national and local May Day actions on May 1 to stand in solidarity with unions, low-paid workers, immigrants, and cross sector community groups; and, be it

FURTHER RESVOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors support May Day actions aimed at stopping Trump's attacks on immigrants, Muslims, and refugees; defending unions and stopping Right to Work laws; repealing the Taft-Hartley Act; fighting discrimination against women, workers of color, immigrants, and LGBT people; supporting women's equality by demanding equal pay for equal work, full reproductive rights, and free childcare; providing jobs for all through rebuilding the infrastructure and public job programs; defeating attempts to destroy the social safety net, including subsidized healthcare; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED. That this resolution be shared widely with city departments. unions, labor councils, and the community to build widespread support for May Day actions on May 1, 2017.
