I strongly support Mary Jung's appointment to the San Francisco Arts Commission as a strong leader and person who will not only be accessible to the community but with her vast experiences on both sides of a Commission's role, will serve this City extremely well.

I have been serving over 8 years on the Joint Committee of our SF Airport Commission and our Art Commission for the oversight needed in the expenditures of art purchases resulting from our City ordinance to require developers to purchase art, as part of their development agreements.


