
#### **Conditions for Type 21 (Off-Sale General)**

- 1. Sales of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 12:00 a.m. Midnight each day of the week.
- 2. No more than 5% of the square footage of the public retail space (not including the storage area) of the premises will be used for the display of alcoholic beverages.
- 3. The sale of distilled spirits in sizes smaller than 375ml is strictly prohibited.
- 4. Beer, malt beverages and wine coolers in containers larger than 32oz. are strictly prohibited.
- 5. Beer, malt beverages and wine coolers in containers of 16oz. or less cannot be sold by single containers, but must be sold in manufacturer pre-packaged multi-unit quantities.
- 6. No wine shall be sold with an alcoholic content of great than 15% by volume except for "Dinner Wines" which have been aged two years or more and maintained in corked bottles.

It should be noted that the applicant has agreed to the above listed conditions


