

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - California Governor’s Office of Emergency Services -  
2 County Victim Services Program - \$771,298]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Office of the District Attorney to accept**  
4 **and expend a grant in the amount of \$771,298 from the California Governor’s**  
5 **Office of Emergency Services for the County Victim Services Program for a grant**  
6 **period from July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2018.**

8 WHEREAS, The Office of the District Attorney applied for funding from the  
9 California Governor’s Office of Emergency Services for the “County Victim Services  
10 Program (XC) Program” and was awarded \$771,298; and

11 WHEREAS, The purpose of the grant is to provide comprehensive coordination  
12 and planning to assist victims and witnesses of crime in the event of a mass casualty  
13 criminal event, and to handle the trauma experienced by victims and witnesses to allow  
14 for faster and more complete recovery from the effects of crime; and

15 WHEREAS, The grant award does not require an amendment to the Annual  
16 Salary Ordinance (ASO); and

17 WHEREAS, The grant award includes a required match of 20% of the project  
18 budget or \$192,825; the source of match is through volunteer hours and general funds;  
19 and

20 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$45,165;  
21 now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Office of the  
23 District Attorney to retroactively accept and expend, on behalf of the City and County of  
24 San Francisco, a grant award of \$771,298 from the California Governor’s Office of  
25 Emergency Services for the County Victim Services Program.
