Attached please find an original and two black and white copies of the proposed resolution for Board of Supervisors approval to enter an Agreement between the City and the lowest bidding authorized reseller of Microsoft products. The Agreement is for an amount not to exceed \$30,328,541, and it covers the period of June 1, 2017 through May 31, 2020.

The timeline for this resolution is urgent because the existing agreements for 27 City Departments to purchase Microsoft products will expire on May 31, 2017. The execution of the new agreement in a timely manner will ensure the City can continue to use the Microsoft Outlook email system, MS Office applications, Windows Servers, as well as many other critical software products used in the City's daily operations.

DT is seeking approval from the Board of Supervisors because Charter section 9.118, "Contract and Lease Limitations," subsection (b) requires Board of Supervisors approval of any contract estimated to exceed \$10 million in expenditures.
