

1 [Proposition J Contract Certification - Security Guard Services]

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3 **Resolution concurring with the Controller's certification that security services at the**  
4 **new Medical Examiner facility at 1 Newhall Street can be performed by a private**  
5 **contractor for a lower cost than similar work performed by City and County employees**  
6 **at the General Services Agency-City Administrator.**

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8 WHEREAS, The Electorate of the City and County of San Francisco passed  
9 Proposition J in November 1976, allowing City and County Departments to contract with  
10 private companies for specific services that can be performed for a lower cost than similar  
11 work by City and County employees (Charter, Section 10.104.15); and,

12 WHEREAS, The Controller has determined that a Purchaser's award of a contract for  
13 the services listed below to a private contractor will achieve substantial cost savings for the  
14 City; and,

15 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco must reconcile a projected \$87.1  
16 million budget deficit for Fiscal Year 2017-2018 with a Charter obligation to enact a balanced  
17 budget each fiscal year; and,

18 WHEREAS, The Mayor has determined that the state of the City's budget for Fiscal  
19 Year 2017-2018 as indicated herein has created an emergency situation justifying a  
20 Purchaser's award of a contract for security services at the Medical Examiner facility (General  
21 Services Agency-City Administrator); and,

22 WHEREAS, The Controller's certification, which confirms that said services can be  
23 performed at lower costs to the City and County by private contractor than by employees of  
24 the City and County, is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 170685,

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1 which is hereby declared to be part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; now, therefore  
2 be it;

3 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby concurs with the Controller's  
4 certification, and the Mayor's determination of an emergency situation, and approves the  
5 Proposition J Resolution concerning the Purchaser's award of a contract to a private  
6 contractor for the services listed below for the period of July 1, 2017, through June 30, 2018.
