[Preparation of Findings to Reverse the Categorical Exemption Determination - Proposed San

Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency - Upper Market Street Safety Project 2 Motion directing the Clerk of the Board to prepare findings reversing the determination 3 by the Planning Department that the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency's 4 5 proposed Upper Market Street Safety Project is categorically exempt from further 6 environmental review. 7 8 On February 3, 2017, the Planning Department determined that the proposed San 9 Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency Project located on Market Street between Castro Street and Octavia Boulevard ("Project") is exempt from environmental review under the 10 California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA"), the CEQA Guidelines, and San Francisco 11 Administrative Code, Chapter 31; and 12 WHEREAS, The proposed Project involves new curb extensions at several locations 13 and related transit island and pedestrian refuge improvements, as well as parking-protected 14 (Class IV) bike lanes on Market Street, and changes to traffic circulation, construction of ADA-15 16 compliant curb ramps, possible relocation of catch basins and manholes, and possible replacement of pull boxes, all within the existing public right-of way; and 17 18 WHEREAS, By letter to the Clerk of the Board, received by the Clerk's Office on June 19 1, 2017, David Pilpel (Appellant), appealed the exemption determination; and WHEREAS, Appellant provided a copy of the Planning Department's Categorical 20 21 Exemption Determination, signed February 3, 2017, which found that the proposed Project 22 was exempt under Class 1 of the CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Reg. Section 15301), which provides an exemption for minor alterations to existing facilities (specifically, to "[e]xisting 23 highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities," 24 25 Section 15301(c)); and

1 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency, by Resolution No. 2 170502-059, approved the proposed Project on May 2, 2017; and 3 WHEREAS, The Planning Department's Environmental Review Officer, by memorandum to the Clerk of the Board dated June 7, 2017, determined that the appeal was 4 5 timely; and 6 WHEREAS, On July 11, 2017, this Board held a duly noticed public hearing to consider 7 the appeal of the exemption determination filed by Appellant and, following the public hearing, 8 reversed the exemption determination subject to the adoption of written findings in support of 9 such determination; and WHEREAS, In reviewing the appeal of the exemption determination, this Board 10 11 reviewed and considered the exemption determination, the appeal letter, the responses to the 12 appeal documents that the Planning Department prepared, the other written records before 13 the Board of Supervisors and all of the public testimony made in support of and opposed to 14 the exemption determination appeal; and 15 WHEREAS, Following the conclusion of the public hearing, the Board of Supervisors 16 conditionally reversed the exemption determination for the project subject to the adoption of 17 written findings of the Board in support of such determination based on the written record 18 before the Board of Supervisors as well as all of the testimony at the public hearing in support 19 of and opposed to the appeal; and 20 WHEREAS, The written record and oral testimony in support of and opposed to the 21 appeal and deliberation of the oral and written testimony at the public hearing before the 22 Board of Supervisors by all parties and the public in support of and opposed to the appeal of 23 the exemption determination is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. 170718, and 24 is incorporated in this motion as though set forth in its entirety; now, therefore, be it 25
