




PROBLEM: HOW DO WE MANAGE AMPLIFIED SOUND IN SAN FRANCISCO?

Our current policies and processes around amplified sound are limited, putting amplified sound activities in boxes that no longer fit, and are challenging to manage and regulate.

For example: our outdoor amplified sound permit is currently being used to permit everything from a rally on the steps of City Hall, to a longterm activation of a plaza, to an amplified band playing in front of a store for a few hours, all the way to a huge Beyoncé concert at AT&T Park.

THE FIX: OVERVIEW OF CHANGES

- The proposed ordinance removes existing provisions in Article 1 of the Police Code (Sections 43 through 48) regarding loudspeaker permits and sound truck permits and codifies new requirements for the use of outdoor amplified sound equipment in Article 15.1 of the Police Code.
- The ordinance retains Section 49 of Article 1 of the Police Code, which is enforced by the Police Department and pertains to "unnecessary noise."

Now when applying for a permit, we will ask:

Does your event/activity involve "Entertainment"?

Limited Live Performance Permit

One Time
Entertainment
Event Permit

Fixed Place Outdoor Amplified Sound Permit

One Time Outdoor Amplified Sound Permit

If the answer is "NO"

NEW TOOLS TO TACKLE OUR CHALLENGES

Changes to Existing Permits in Article 15.1:

- Place of Entertainment Permits
 - To include outdoor amplified sound
- Limited Live Performance Permits
 - To include outdoor amplified sound
- One Time (Entertainment) Event Permits
 - Pertains to events furnishing "entertainment" either indoor or outdoor
 - Limited to 12 per year

New Amplified Sound Permits:

- Fixed Place Outdoor Amplified Sound Permit
 - For ongoing use of outdoor amplified sound where "entertainment" is not being furnished
- One Time Outdoor Amplified Sound Permit
 - One time events where "entertainment" is not being furnished.
 - Limited to 12 per year
