3	Resolution determining that the transfer of a Type 20 off-sale beer and wine
4	license Garfield Beach CVS, LLC, dba CVS, located at 799 Beach Street
5	(District 2), will serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and County
6	of San Francisco in accordance with California Business and Professions Code,
7	Section 23958.4; and recommending that the California Department of Alcoholic
8	Beverage Control impose conditions on the issuance of the license.

10	WHEREAS, Garfield Beach CVS, LLC, dba CVS is seeking the transfer of a
11	Type 20 off-sale beer and wine license located at 799 Beach Street (District 2); and
12	WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly
13	zoned and recommends approval; and
14	WHEREAS, The Police Department has filed zero (0) protests and zero (0)
15	letters of support with the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control under California
16	Business and Professions Code, Section 24013, and recommends that the Department
17	of Alcoholic Beverage Control issue the liquor license with conditions; and
18	WHEREAS, The conditions recommended by the Police Department are the
19	following: 1) sales of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted between the hours of 8:00
20	a.m. and 11:00 p.m. daily; 2) no more than 5% of the square footage of the premises
21	will be used for the display of alcoholic beverages; 3) the sales of beer or malt
22	beverages in quantities of 16 ounces, 22 ounces, 32 ounces, 40 ounces, or similar size
23	containers is prohibited; 4) no beer, malt beverages, or wine coolers in containers of 16
24	ounces or less shall be sold by single containers, but must be sold in manufacturer pre-
25	packaged multi-unit quantities; 5) no malt beverage shall be sold with an alcoholic

content greater than 5.7% by volume; 6) wine shall not be sold in bottles or containers
smaller than 750 milliliters; 7) no wine shall be sold with an alcoholic content of greater
than 15% by volume; 8) graffiti shall be removed from the premises and all parking lots
under the control of the licensee within 72 hours of application; if the graffiti occurs on a
Friday or weekend day, or on a holiday, the licensee shall remove the graffiti within 72
hours following the beginning of the next week day; and 9) loitering (defined as "to stand
idly about; linger aimlessly without lawful business") is prohibited on any sidewalks of
property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the licensee as depicted
on the ABC-275; now, therefore, be it
RESOLVED, That in accordance with California Business and Professions Code,
Section 23958.4, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
hereby determines that the transfer of a Type 20 off-sale beer and wine license to
Garfield Beach CVS, dba CVS, located at 799 Beach Street (District 2), will serve the
public convenience or necessity of the City and County of San Francisco; and, be it
FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of
San Francisco hereby endorses and adopts the recommendations of the Police
Department listed above and recommends that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage
Control issue the license with those conditions.
