



I, Ruslan Gurvits, have been recruited by Ms. Adrienne Pon, Chair of the Immigration Rights Commission, to become an Immigration Commissioner representing, advocating, and working on behalf of immigrants.

I want to introduce myself to you. I am extremely honored to have this opportunity to share my story with you and hopefully work with you and other public officials to advocate on behalf of our communities.

I immigrated to the United States from Ukraine when I was seven years old as a refugee. I am so fortunate and thankful for since then becoming a US Citizen. I dedicated my childhood towards helping other immigrants by translating legal documents and accompanying them to doctor appointments to help them communicate with medical professionals. I have witnessed my parents struggle in their new home and thus understand the challenges that come with immigration.

In many ways, I am the walking representation of the American Dream and all this country stands for. As an immigrant refugee, I have been fortunate to be accepted to UC Berkeley and since then graduated with degrees in Economics and Public Policy. I have been fortunate to have access to healthcare, information, knowledge, and opportunity. I understand the struggle. I am thankful for it. I want others to have the same opportunities that have been blessed to me.

As a Jewish immigrant from Ukraine, I would be the only Russian-speaking and Jewish immigrant representative on the commission. There are an estimated 800,000 Russian speakers in the San Francisco Bay Area region (<a href="http://www.russianamericanmedia.com/who-we-are/russian-americans/demographics/">http://www.russianamericanmedia.com/who-we-are/russian-americans/demographics/</a>), many of which are immigrants. There are an estimated 400,000 Jewish people in the San Francisco Bay Area (<a href="http://www.jweekly.com/2015/11/06/bay-area-jewish-population-nears-400000/">http://www.jweekly.com/2015/11/06/bay-area-jewish-population-nears-400000/</a>). These estimates demonstrate the significance of having 1 representative on this committee who can speak to, advocate, and be accessible to these persons.

As the grandson of Holocaust survivors, I represent what America is capable of. While I am a fluent Russian speaker and Jewish, as an Immigration Commissioner, I would represent, advocate on behalf of, and work for all immigrants including but not limited to those from the Latino, Hispanic, and Asian communities, regardless of legal status.

#### **Board Qualifications:**

The Immigrant Rights Commission consists of fifteen (15) voting members. Eleven (11) voting members are appointed by the Board of Supervisors and the other four (4) voting members are appointed by the Mayor.

At least eight (8) members shall be immigrants to the United States who are appointed in accordance with Charter, Section 4.101. It has been past practice that six (6) of the immigrant members are appointed by the Board of Supervisors and two (2) immigrant members are appointed by the Mayor. All members must have a demonstrated knowledge of and interest in the health, human service, educational, or employment issues that affect immigrants residing in San Francisco and shall reflect the geographic, ethic, and sexual orientation population of San Francisco.

The term of each member of the Commission shall be two years; provided, however, that the members first appointed shall, by lot, classify their terms so that eight (8) members shall serve a term of three years and seven (7) members shall serve a term of two years. In the event a vacancy occurs during the term of office of any member, a successor shall be appointed to complete the unexpired term of the office vacated in a manner similar to that for the initial member.

The Immigrant Rights Commission shall advise and make recommendations to the Board of Supervisors and the Mayor about issues affecting immigrants residing in San Francisco.
