10	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
11	Section 1. Findings
12	(a) Harvey Milk was the first openly gay elected official in San Francisco, elected to the
13	Board of Supervisors in 1977, and serving until his tragic death in 1978. He is a human rights
14	leader known all over the world for his work in fighting discrimination against the LGBT
15	community, as well as speaking out for migrant farm workers, low-income tenants, the labor
16	movement, homeless youth in the Castro, and many others. He believed strongly that we
17	have to give hope to young people who still (as in Milk's day) suffer bullying in schoolyards,
18	anti-gay violence from family and others, and psychological damage from growing up in a
19	homophobic and transphobic society.
20	(b) In order to honor one of the nation's great gay leaders, raise awareness of the
21	history of the LGBT movement, and give hope to young LGBT people in cities everywhere,
22	the Board of Supervisors finds it fitting that a terminal at the San Francisco International
23	Airport be named in honor of Harvey Milk.

(c) The San Francisco International Airport has four terminals, currently referred to as

Terminal 1, Terminal 2, Terminal 3, and the International Terminal. At its June 26, 2017

1	meeting, the Airport Facilities Naming Advisory Committee voted to recommend that Terminal
2	1 be named for Harvey Milk. Terminal 1 is currently being reconstructed, and when it re-
3	opens in 2022, will set a new standard in style and efficiency for airports.
4	
5	Section 2. The Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding Section 2A.174, to
6	read as follows:
7	SEC. 2A.174. NAMING TERMINAL 1 OF THE SAN FRANCISCO INTERNATIONAL
8	AIRPORT FOR HARVEY MILK.
9	(a) Terminal 1 of the San Francisco International Airport shall be named for Harvey Milk.
10	(b) By no later than December 1, 2018, the Director of the Airport shall submit a report to the
11	Board of Supervisors and the Mayor describing the steps the Airport has taken and plans to take to
12	implement this Section 2A.174 and publicize the name of the terminal.
13	
14	Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
15	enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
16	ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
17	of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
