WHEREAS, Over the last two decades, indigenous Mayan-speaking immigrants from the Yucatan region of Mexico have made their home in San Francisco, particularly in the northern Mission and Tenderloin neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, In Chan Kaajal is in the Mayan language meaning little town, and in Spanish this translates to Mi Pueblito; and

WHEREAS, The existence of Yucatecan business, cultural associations, and social services and organization serving this community is a testament to their presence; and

WHEREAS, The name In Chan Kaajal represents the contributions and significance of the local Mayan speaking community; and

WHEREAS, The Mayan name In Chan Kaajal, and its Spanish translation Mi Pueblito is significant because it resonates with the surrounding Latino population, weaving together the community's indigenous and Spanish European roots; and

WHEREAS, Significant outreach and community meetings have taken place since early September 2016 with People Organizing to Demand Environmental and Economic Rights (PODER), with the San Francisco Recreation and Park Department; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Recreation and Park Commission to name the new park located at 2080 Folsom Street (on 17th and Folsom Streets) as In Chan Kaajal Park; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Board shall send a copy of this resolution to the Recreation and Park Commission, and the Recreation and Park Department.
