Ordinance amending the Existing Building and Fire Codes to require buildings sold or transferred after September 1, 2017, to comply with fire alarm system upgrade requirement for sleeping areas, and to exempt mandatory seismic strengthening alterations and transient Hotels from those requirement; affirming the Planning Department's determination under the California Environmental Quality Act; making findings under the California Health and Safety Code; and directing the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to forward this Ordinance to the California Building Standards Commission upon final passage.

The Building Inspection Commission met and held a public hearing on August 16, 2017 regarding the proposed amendment to the San Francisco Building and Fire Codes. The Commissioners voted 4 to 3 to support the Building Code amendment, with Commissioners Walker, Clinch, and Warshell dissenting. There was extensive discussion among the Commissioners that they supported the intent of the legislation; however they wanted to know the basis for transient hotels being excluded from the legislation.
